Situation

ntoskrnl.exe error Message on boot after restoring image

Solution

This is likely due to boot.ini pointing the wrong partition.

Either edit boot.ini and point to the right partition

or

Boot into Windows recovery environment. At the command prompt type bootcfg /rebuild. Answer y to the first prompt, enter in the load identifier of the installation (ie Windows 2003 Server), do not need to enter anything for OS Load Options.

Type exit to quit the recovery environment and reboot. You should be now able to boot into windows
